What Are Regional Associations

Regional associations are nonprofit membership associations of grantmakers and related organizations that work to strengthen philanthropy in distinct geographic regions – cities, states, or multi-state areas. For people and organizations practicing responsible philanthropy, or aspiring to do so, regional associations of grantmakers are permanent support systems and focal points for collaboration, community building and lifelong learning.
